

Session 18

In Today's meeting continued Dr. Maya Soetoro's lecture, where she guided us through the concepts of navigational leadership, restorative justice, and nonviolent social change. These concepts added new depth and nuance to topics we had previously explored, particularly leadership and justice. Dr. Soetoro explained in detail the steps leaders should take after actions have been taken to create change and promote justice, emphasizing that taking action once does not mean the work is finished. She concluded by reminding students of the ongoing process required to achieve peace and highlighting the importance of listening to and understanding communities. By centering the voices and experiences of communities, leaders can create more meaningful and lasting change.
