# **DISCUSSION PROMPTS**

- 1. Thad makes fun of Beni because of his interest in video games and comic books. But then Thad shows up at Taíno Comics and Games. What did you expect Thad to do in the comic bookstore? Did your view of Thad change after this scene? Why or why not?
- 2. The Venturas track a powerful hurricane as it approaches Puerto Rico, a Caribbean island where they have family living. We experience the characters' reactions through their lines (dialogue). What is another way the audience receives information about the hurricane in these scenes? Why do you think the series creators decided to tell that part of the story in this style?
- 3. Alexa and her mother visit a genealogy website to find information about members of their family. They discover something that alters Alexa's perspective about the timestorm. What piece of information changes Alexa's mind? How else could Alexa have searched for this information?

# WHAT'S THE WORD?

**Hurricane** - (noun) - A hurricane is a type of storm called a tropical cyclone, which forms over tropical or subtropical waters. (National Ocean Service: <u>oceanservice.noaa.gov/facts/hurricane.html</u>)

**Microbe** - (noun) - Microscopic organisms that consist of a single cell or a cluster of cells too small to be seen with the naked eye. Also called microorganisms. Microbes, or microorganisms, live in the air, water, the earth, and our bodies. Some help us stay healthy while others can make us sick.

### FICTION AND FACTS

#### Subject: Rafael Hernández School

On the Show: Alexa and Beni are seventh graders at Rafael Hernández School in north Newark. The school is named in honor of Rafael Hernández, a famous Puerto Rican musician and U.S. Army veteran who fought in World War I.

*In Real Life:* Rafael Hernández School serves pre-K through eighth grade. The school is named after Afro-Puerto Rican musician Rafael Hernández, who was born in Aguadilla, Puerto Rico in 1892. At the age of 25, Rafael was recruited to join a U.S. Army musical band and was deployed to France during World War I. After the war, he went on to become a prolific composer as well as a bandleader, actor, music store owner, and founder of little league baseball in Puerto Rico.

#### Subject: Hurricane Maria: Landfall & Immediate Aftermath

*On the Show:* The Venturas listen to weather updates about a dangerous hurricane barreling toward Puerto Rico and their family members that live there. Once the storm arrives, all communication is cut off with the island, and the Venturas struggle to cope with the uncertain circumstances.

*In Real Life:* Hurricane Maria devastated many Caribbean islands. The storm made landfall in Puerto Rico on September 20, 2017, only two weeks after Hurricane Irma passed north of the island. About 80,000 residents were already without power from the previous storm when Hurricane Maria knocked out the entire electrical grid of the main island as well as the smaller islands, Vieques and Culebra. Nearly all methods of communication were crippled. Immediate emergencies included flooding, road destruction, contamination of the water supply, loss of crops and livestock, food shortages, lack of access to urgent medical care, and human fatalities.
