- Students would be fed breakfast, be given mask breaks outside, would be fed lunch and would have time for recess.
- Students would have access to a Chromebook and the internet to complete assignments in Google Classroom.
- We could accommodate **approximately 32 students**. Students would be in our cafeteria and would be sitting at least six feet apart.
- We would use the following criteria to help us decide who would qualify for the group:
 - Parents who are essential workers without access to daycare
 - The home doesn't have access to the internet or wi-fi
 - o The student has an IEP or 504
 - The student would attend all of the days offered
 - The student would follow all of our CR3 Expectations
