The IHSA Organizational Contest will be held Saturday, April 13, 2024 at Rantoul High School in Rantoul, IL. This is a REQUIRED, GRADED event for all students. Please know that because this is an IHSA sponsored contest, school eligibility rules apply and will be followed. Students that are reported on the eligibility list with an 'F' for the week in question will not be able to attend the contest. In order to receive a grade, these students will have a make-up assignment which will be assigned on Monday, April 8th and is due on Friday, April 12th.

Contest Location: Rantoul Township High School - 200 S. Sheldon Street, Rantoul

Itinerary for Saturday, April 13th

7:10am – All students arrive to school wearing concert black. Load buses.

8:20am – Arrive at Rantoul High School, unload and find homeroom.

At this time band students will be free to attend performances. DO NOT BE DISRUPTIVE.

NO CELL PHONE USE during any performance. (Watch the Heyworth High School choir perform at 9:00 and then go IMMEDIATELY to our homeroom.)

8:40am –**HIGH SCHOOL CHOIR MOVES TO WARM-UPS**

9:00am –**HIGH SCHOOL CHOIR PERFORMANCE in small gym**

Following the performance choir students will be free to attend performances. DO NOT BE DISRUPTIVE. NO

CELL PHONE USE during any performance. (Please plan on watching the High School Band perform and then go IMMEDIATELY to our homeroom.)

9:25am – All band students meet in homeroom and prepare to move to warm-ups.

9:30am –**HIGH SCHOOL BAND MOVES TO WARM-UPS**

10:00am–**HIGH SCHOOL BAND PERFORMANCE in large gym**

10:30am – Gather belongings and load busses

12:00pm – Arrival at Heyworth High School (approximate)
