Iron Painter

24 Hour IronMan Painting Event 10:00 AM Saturday November 16th to 10:00 AM Sunday November 17th

Iron Painter is a 24 hour endurance painting event that challenges participants to paint a complete wargaming army in one 24 hour period. It is a mighty test of hobby skill and fortitude. Those who successfully complete it earn the title "Iron Painter" and serious bragging rights-especially the competitor that gets the most votes for Best Army!

Army Composition

Participants must paint a legal army for the system they are choosing to compete in that consists of at least 30 models. Models may be assembled and primed in white, grey, or black. Bases may be textured if the competitor wishes. Resin cast bases may be used as well. No paint other than the aforementioned primer may be on the models prior to 10:00 Saturday. For clarification by game system see below:

28-30 mm scale (Warhammer 40,000, Warhammer, Warmachine, Infinity, etc.)

Armies must be a legally playable army in a standard format game. Vehicles, infantry, bikes, etc. all count as one model. Models that consist of multiple models (like a bike and rider for instance) still only collectively count as one model. Objective markers may NOT be included towards your minimum model count, though they may be included in the overall army if you wish.

10-15 mm scale (Flames of War, Dropzone Commander, etc.)

Armies must be a legally playable army in a standard format game. Tanks, walkers, transports, etc all count as one model. An infantry or gun team stand of multiple models collectively counts as one model. Objective markers may NOT be included towards your minimum model count, though they may be included in the overall army if you wish.

If you still have questions regarding whether your army is legal, what a model is, or anything else related to Iron Painter please contact Legio Malaysia for clarification.

Event Rules

The event will begin at 10:00 AM Saturday and finish at 10:00 AM on Sunday. No materials will be provided, so be sure to bring everything you need to paint your army. Airbrushes may be used if you wish- power points will be available on hand. If you choose to use an airbrush, ensure your compressor does not make excessively loud noise that will disturb other painters. Likewise, headphones must be used if you wish to listen to music or other media. You may come and go as you wish to take breaks, eat, sleep, etc. but your army has to be

entirely painted on site and nowhere else. You are the only person permitted to paint your army-you may not enlist aid of any kind during the event (other than to perhaps solicit opinions/suggestions from your fellow painters). This is not a team event.

You must be on hand for the beginning and the end of the competition to be eligible for voting and possible victory- a proxy cannot accept an award in your place. The award ceremony will be held at 12 noon on Sunday- this will give folks time to review the painted armies and vote for their favorite. Iron Painter will be held at Hobby Forge in Zenith Corporate Park, KJ.

Determining the Winner

The overall winner of Iron Painter will be determined by popular vote, with all present eligible to vote (other than the painters themselves). Armies will be displayed with a number, and voters will choose their favorite army by writing the number of their choice on an entry slip. Each person may only vote once.

While there is indeed a sole winner, EVERYONE who finishes will be a Legio Malaysia Iron Painter. All finishers will get a framed certificate proving their achievement. For the truly dedicated/insane, there are two additional sub-awards that may be earned:

Adamantium Mantle

Winners of the Adamantium Mantle begin the competition with their army still sealed in boxes and blisters. They must ASSEMBLE and paint the army within 24 hours. This is extremely difficult to do with any degree of painting quality!

Iron Halo

Winners of the Iron Halo successfully complete **50** models within the alloted time, rather than "just" 30. Hardcore!

Registration

There is a RM10 non refundable fee to participate in the Iron Painter- simply pay this is either Jeff Brooks or Khairul Effendy when you register. There will be a limited number of entrants allowed for this due to space constraints, so be sure to register early. You also need to submit your army list for verification with us, and be aware that the event organizers will also be participating in the event. Organizer lists for the event will be published well in advance if you are interested.
