

Standing Committee Descriptions

The Juniorettes Committee

- 1.) The Juniorettes Committee assists the Juniorettes Chair(s) in managing a service organization of girls ages 12-18. Members are needed to mentor, chaperone, and assist this awesome group of girls as they conduct their own monthly meetings (typically on the 3rd Sunday of the month at 2 pm at the Lemont Public Library) and plan and implement service projects to support the Lemont community. Juniorettes Committee Members are highly encouraged to attend many of the Sunday Juniorettes meetings in order to develop relationships with the girls.
 - Past Juniorettes events/service projects include: Tie dying shirts at the Hope & Friendship Unbirthday party (August), making a themed scarecrow for the LJWC Scarecrow Trail, organizing the Annual Monster and Me Mile Run fundraiser on the day of the LPD Harvest Fest (October), making bread/wrapping books to donate for Hope and Friendship (November/December), making Warm a Heart Bags for Hope&Friendship (January), Galentine's brunch (February), organizing Leprechaun My Lawn Fundraiser (March), conducting Her Drive (female hygiene products) (April), Ice Cream Social (May).

The Philanthropies Committee

- 2.) The Ways & Means Committee

Volunteer opportunities in this committee typically include manning tables onsite at weekend/weeknight events.
