Meeting was called to order by Chapter President Jordan Hofmeier around 5:00pm.

Minutes for the 2018 meeting were reviewed individually and Bill Stark moved to accept the minutes and Bryan Sowards seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Carson Cox was thanked for his long-time contribution as the awards committee chair.

Fundraising Committee Chair Jeff Conley discussed this year's raffle. The 2018 raffle will have two less items, a lifetime hunting or fishing license (transferable), and a smith-root electrofishing class.
