Senate Bill 9

Passed during the 87th (2nd) Legislative Session, Senate Bill 9 requires schools beginning in the 2022-23 school year to educate students on dating violence, family violence, and child abuse.

Any lessons on reproduction begin in the 4th grade Health TEKS. The complete TEA Health TEKS can be found here. Health TEKS

Parents/guardians will have the option to opt-in to individual sensitive lessons. A student who is not opted-in to receive instruction over grade-appropriate Senate Bill 9 curriculum will receive an alternative lesson.

All students will receive non-sensitive lessons that address grade-level TEKS.
