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Introduction

Manuscripts must be typed using Times New Roman font with 1.5 double columns, font size 12 on A4 paper. In general, the contents consist of Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results and Discussion, Conclusion, Acknowledgments and References. The manuscript must be equipped with 3-5 keywords.

Materials and methods

The method used must be accompanied by a bibliography or quotation. The work procedures are listed in detail if the process

or analysis methods are special (modified) or new. The methodological description should clearly and concisely describe the research in sufficient detail.

Results

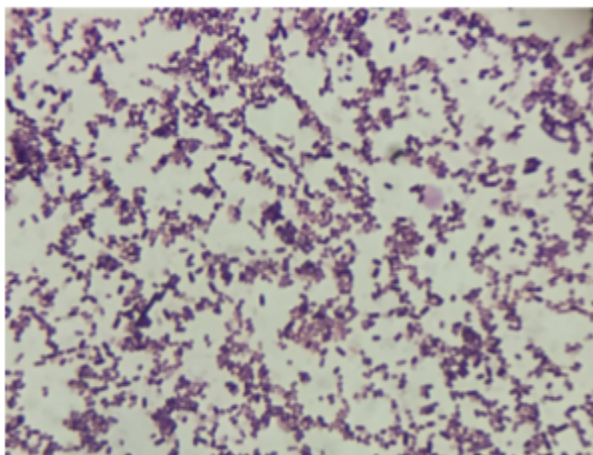


Figure 1. [Illustration text and caption should centered, font size 12]

Present the research results and their significance. All illustrations including images, charts and graphs must be labeled. The desired placement in the text must be clearly indicated. These illustrations must be referenced and numbered sequentially, such as pictures (Figure 1) or tables (Table 1).

Discussion

References in the text should be indicated by providing the name of the author. All references listed alphabetically must be included at the end of the manuscript. All references cited in the text must appear in the reference list. The author is responsible for the accuracy and completeness of all information in the reference. References in the manuscript use APA Style (American Psychological Association). The referencing style used should be consistent throughout the manuscript.

Conclusion

Research results are briefly presented in answer to the questions raised previously, as well as conclusions or suggestions that can be drawn from this research. This conclusion takes the form of a sentence in a paragraph.

Acknowledgements

Acknowledgments are addressed to people, grants, funds, etc., and should be placed in a separate section before the list of references. The name of the funding organization must be written in full. The study's financial support affiliation, if any, must be stated in this section.
