

SciEngage Overview

SciEngage aims to bring together practitioners, professionals and other stakeholders from across the public engagement with science community to discuss relevant issues, topical programs, and the connection between research and practice. Our aim is to foster conversations between, rather than within, different sectors: science communication, public engagement, evaluation, journalism, and informal science education. Ultimately, our goal is to have SciEngage serve as a community-driven platform that participants can use to 1) enhance their own professional capacity, and 2) collaborate with others within the community to collectively strengthen the field of public engagement.
