

Judge issues partial injunction of state's Voter ID law

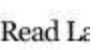
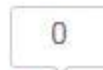
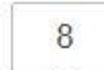
Commonwealth Judge Robert Simpson this morning issued a partial injunction of the state's voter ID law.

Voters will still be asked to present a valid ID, and if they don't have one, will have to cast a provisional ballot.

However, voters will not be required to return within six days to show a valid identification card, as was required by the law passed earlier this year.

Instead, the Nov. 6 election will be considered another step in the transition to full implementation of the law.
