We were told that Admin would pay for those items since all events/activities held at the church use them and it would be simpler.

Dee went over the budget following the meeting and she and Carol met again on the 16th to go over the changes, which she submitted to finance.

We also discussed the possibility of the Abiding Dudes smoking hams for Easter Sunday. If it happens, it will tentatively be an Outreach Committee fundraiser and therefore not covered under the Fellowship budget. Dudes will handle arrangements and announcements.
