Lunch Program Update for 2025–2026

Beginning in the 2025–2026 school year, Pope John XXIII School will no longer be using the FSP lunch program. FSP has informed us that they will no longer be able to provide personnel to heat and serve lunches, which makes it necessary for us to transition to a new provider.

We are pleased to announce that we will be partnering with Kiddo's Catering to provide hot lunch service for our students. Kiddo's Catering is a well-established school lunch provider known for offering fresh, kid-friendly meals sourced from local restaurants. Their online ordering system allows families to select meals in advance, and their menus include a variety of options that include vegetarian meals.

Due to our enrollment being under 250 students, lunch service through Kiddo's Catering will be offered three days a week on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. On Mondays and Fridays, all students will need to bring lunch from home.

More information about how to register and order lunches through Kiddo's Catering will be sent home before the end of the school year.

We look forward to this new partnership and thank you for your support as we continue to provide delicious and convenient lunch options for our students.
