



## **Letter to Father Rossi Due December 15, 2025**

The Church considers you of age to reasonably understand what it means to live as a Catholic Christian. The Church believes you are able to freely make the choice to strengthen your beliefs and receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. One who makes such a choice realizes the importance of living as a witness to Jesus Christ, and already tries to do so.

Father Rossi, as the first and foremost teacher in Saint Agnes Parish (authority given to him by virtue of the title “pastor”) assumes responsibility for presenting each candidate to the bishop. In doing so, he acknowledges that each candidate is properly prepared to receive the sacrament.

Therefore, you are asked to write a letter to Father Rossi with the purpose of informing Father as to your readiness for the sacrament.

### **Follow these guidelines as you compose your letter:**

† Type, print or legibly write your letter in letter format

† **Paragraph one:** Introduce yourself. Tell something about your family. Tell something about your sponsor and why you chose him/her. Give 1 or 2 reasons why you want to be confirmed.

† **Paragraph two:** Explain the things you are doing to personally prepare for the sacrament. Tell about your prayer life, your Mass attendance, and the way you serve others. Also include the importance of receiving the Sacraments of Penance and Eucharist and how often you receive them.

† **Paragraph three:** Thank Father for being a witness to Jesus and his faithful service. Ask him to pray for you as you continue to prepare for Confirmation, and let him know that you will pray for him.

**\*Remember to have a Closing and Sign your letter.**
