Course Overview

This will be a hybrid EMT class. This class will utilize Emergency Care 14e edition along with the MyLab package for online learning. Students will be required to complete all online assignments by the date on the syllabus this will allow the student to be prepared for skill days. Using this method will allow us to have more hands-on experience during class time. The goal of all students from this class is to obtain their Emergency Medical Technician Certification.

- Emergency Medical Technician (4 year certification)
- The Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) certification program is designed to train an individual to function independently in a medical emergency. The course provides the basic knowledge and skills needed to deliver Basic Life Support (BLS) care and is required to progress to more advanced levels of prehospital patient care.
