

CHROMEBOOK USE POLICY

POLICY

As a technology-integrated school, Spectrum High School (SHS) promotes the use of digital technology as a means to improve student achievement. In doing so, SHS may provide a Chromebook to students for a period of time to be used at school, off campus, or both. All students and parents must meet all requirements, and sign and return a *Chromebook Use Agreement* prior to the student being assigned a device. Each device is the responsibility of the student and must be returned in the same condition it was received. Misuse of the device may result in disciplinary consequences, including loss of privileges. SHS will provide access to internet while on campus, but is not responsible for internet access off campus. SHS may make insurance available to cover the Chromebook during the school year. If parents/students choose not to avail themselves of the available insurance, a full replacement fee may be assessed if the Chromebook is damaged beyond repair, lost, or stolen.

Administration will establish procedures to ensure ease of distribution, use, and return of Chromebooks. It is understood that the procedure may require minimal fees for use to cover the costs of maintaining and ensuring long term access to devices for student use.
