Drama: The Moment Before an Entrance

- 1. The Moment Before an Entrance- What can I do back-stage while waiting for my cue to enter? First of all, I must convince myself that I exist now--- not yesterday. I cannot think that I will repeat my last performance or my last rehearsal, yet I have to trust that whatever I found in my rehearsal exercises and homework will serve me now. Spontaneity, a feeling of immediacy, can only be achieved if I give my whole attention to this moment. My three essential steps of preparation for an entrance focus on the circumstances, time, place, and objective of my character. Specifically, these essential steps before an entrance are:
 - A. What did I (my character) just do (off stage)?
 - B. What am I doing right now?
 - C. What's the first thing I want when I go on stage?
