

Discussion 1: Introduce Your Community and Padlet Reflection Assignment

Learning Outcome:

- Discuss what social change means to you and your community according to the history, cultural perspectives, and environmental circumstances they have experienced.

Instructions:

Our personal biographies are connected to the larger social contexts in which we live, with social forces and historical patterns shaping the conditions that influence our individual lives. For the Reflection Assignment, "Social Change, My Community, and Me," you have begun to explore ideas about how change in society is influencing the lives of your community.

Step One:

1. Return to your Padlet where you are developing your Reflection Assignment, "Social Change, My Community, and Me", and make sure that your visitor permissions are set to: "Can read". This will ensure that your document will not be edited by a visitor.

3. Provide an overview of your ideas that have contributed to your Padlet:

Describe the community you are a part of, why it is an important community to you. Explain your starting ideas about the 3 categories: Cultural, Historical, Environmental.

Step Two:

Respond to one classmate with your thoughts about their Padlet. What are your initial reactions? Have they explained their ideas clearly enough for you to understand? If not, ask for some clarification.

You will need to post a contribution to the discussion question by Wednesday at midnight and respond to one other classmate's post by Sunday at midnight. Be sure to write at least 250 words for each post.

You are welcome to add as many posts and responses as you would like, but note that you will only be graded on those that are requested in the instructions. Be sure to build on the discussion topics and apply course material, beyond simply agreeing with others posts. Late discussion posts are not accepted. Please always abide by our Netiquette policies as well. We are striving to create an engaged, respectful, and lively discussion board. I look forward to your insights.
