For all venues:

Venue safety:

fbi.radio has zero tolerance for racist, homophobic, transphobic, ableist, sexist or any other discriminatory behaviour. Any patrons who behave as such will be asked to leave the event immediately.

Friday, October 3: Opening Night Concert

Getting there:

The location of SYDCITY's Opening Night Concert will be shared with ticketholders via email on the morning of October 3.

The venue is a 5-10 minute walk from Sydenham station, and close by to the 423 & 426 bus stops near Sydenham Road. There may be residential parking available within a 5-10 min walk of the venue.

Venue access:

The Opening Night Concert is strictly an 18+ event.

STRICTLY NO PASSOUTS - Once you're in, you're in.

The entrance has a front step and thus is unfortunately not wheelchair accessible. Alternate entry may be possible to this venue - please email access@fbiradio.com.

There are gender neutral bathrooms located upstairs, and downstairs, neither are wheelchair accessible. The downstairs bathroom has a raised step and no ramping, and the upstairs one up a flight of stairs.

The performance space is currently a standing only space - please contact access@fbiradio.com for any queries on this front.

Sensory Information:

The performance space will be lowly-lit, with light haze used. No strobes will be used.

The venue has a medium-sized outdoor space with seating, separate from the performance space. It will be open throughout the duration of the event.

Amenities

This venue is **BYO only**. No alcohol, food or other drinks will be on sale at this event.

There will be free water provided, in the outdoor space, separate from the performance space.

Earplugs are recommended. There will be some free, limited disposable earplugs and some higher-fidelity ones for sale at the merch stand.

Saturday, October 4: Day>Night Festival

Getting there:

Petersham Bowling Club is located at 77 Brighton St, Petersham.

It's an approx. 10 minute walk from Petersham Station. It's also a few minutes from the 413 bus stop, or 5-6 minutes from Parramatta Road bus stops. There may be residential parking available close by, but likely to be busy on a Saturday.

[There are two entrances to the club - via a footpath on The Avenue, or via the driveway on Brighton St.](#)

Venue access:

Minors are permitted at Petersham Bowling club strictly with adult accompaniment.

[Petersham Bowling Club is in the midst of an accessibility upgrade plan](#), but it's entrance is currently not wheelchair accessible.

Entry is via the front door at the end of the driveway entrance. It has 10 steps to reach the performance space, and is thus unfortunately not wheelchair accessible.

There are accessible toilets located in the venue. These toilets are gendered.

There are tables and couches at the back of the performance space, with views of the stage.

Sensory Information:

The performance space has ample natural light throughout the day, and will be cosily lit during the evening. There will be no strobes or haze used.

The bar and restaurant sit side-by-side to the performance space, and thus there may be some light traffic in this space during the performances.

There is a large outdoor space with seating outside of the performance space, which is open to the public throughout the event. Paid patrons will be able to enter and re-enter the performance space throughout the day.

Amenities

Petersham Bowling Club is a **licenced venue** - BYO not permitted. There will be food and drink on sale throughout the day, and free water available at the bar.

Earplugs are recommended. There will be some free, limited disposable earplugs and some higher-fidelity ones for sale at the merch stand.

Saturday, October 4: Day>Night Festival

Getting there:

Red Rattler Theatre is located at 6 Faversham St, Marrickville.

It's an approx 12 minute walk from Sydenham Station. There may be residential parking available within a 5-10 min walk of the venue.

Venue access:

The Afterparty is strictly an 18+ event.

The Red Rattler building is accessible through a graded driveway (dropped kerb). Entry is through a door to a short hallway with a mild incline ramp.

The performance space is wheelchair accessible. The venue has wheelchair accessible and gender-neutral bathrooms. There is a lowered area to the right of the bar for wheelchair users to purchase drinks.

There is seating on either side of the performance space, and close to the entrance of the room.

Sensory Information:

The performance space will be dimly lit. No strobes will be used.

Amenities

Red Rattler is a **licensed venue** - BYO not permitted. There will be drinks on sale throughout the night, and free water available at the bar.

Earplugs are recommended. There will be some free, limited disposable earplugs and some higher-fidelity ones for sale at the merch stand.
