

###AN ACT

#to permit a mechanism through which the World Health Organization may operate within the borders of the United States following congressional or presidential approval

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States in Congress assembled.

****SECTION 1. Short Title and Findings****

> A. This act may be cited and recorded as the World Health Organization Authorization Act, or acronymized as the WHOAA.

****SEC. 2. Authorization****

> A. Consent may be given for the World Health Organization (hereinafter ‘WHO’ to operate within the borders of the United States by the following methods—

> > i. Via presidential proclamation, which shall expire upon an additional proclamation willing it so, or

> > ii. Via a joint resolution of Congress.

****SEC. 3. Enactment****

> A. This Act will take effect immediately upon being signed by the President, or their veto being successfully overridden; or upon the requisite amount of time having lapsed since the President was presented with this act.

> B. The provisions of this act are severable. Should any clause be struck or rendered unenforceable, the remainder will retain the force of law.
