Officers cleared in shooting case

Two Memphis police officers who shot and killed a suspect May 8 have been cleared in the case, officials said Wednesday.

Officers Pierce Hayden and Steve Theriac shot and killed Dewayne Bailey, 38, after they said he tried to run them over.

According to police, Bailey was sleeping in his car in the parking lot at 4046 Horn Lake near Third. When police arrived, they tried to wake him.

When Bailey finally woke, he was agitated, police said, and then tried to run them over with his car.

The two officers fired, killing Bailey.

Both officers returned to duty Monday.
