

Russian Immersion 3-4

Grade Levels: 9th - 12th

Prerequisites: Russian Immersion in High School or Teacher Discretion

Course Numbers: 1292RB1, 1292RB2

Credit Type: World Languages or Elective

Course Description:

This course is designed to increase the proficiency of Russian immersion students in all modalities of the Russian language (speaking, reading, writing skills, and listening). The fundamentals of critical thinking and literary analysis are taught through reading and analyzing short stories, poems, and longer works. Also, the study of grammar and contextual vocabulary is done through the study of art, literature, history, culture, and current events. The topics of this course are around geography and global issues.

Student Workload:

Students are expected to speak only in Russian in class.
