- Eisenhower High School was founded in August 2011 when the district split the existing high school
- School colors are Columbia Blue and Black.
- Mascot is the White Tiger.
- Classification is 5A.
- Member of the Arkansas Valley Chisholm Trail League (AVCTL).
- EHS has 4 administrators, 70 certified staff, 3 counselors and 2 full-time nurses.
- 47 staff members have a master's degree.
- Class of 2024 GPA:
  - Top 10% - 3.98 GPA or better
  - Top 25% - 3.85 GPA or better
  - Top 50% - 3.52 GPA or better
- The full-time student count is 981:
  - Seniors – 243 students
  - Juniors – 230 students
  - Sophomores – 259 students
  - Freshmen – 249 students
- Class of 2024: 46 Kansas Scholars Curriculum Completers, with 30 qualifying as Kansas Designated State Scholars, 3 National Merit Commended.
- 2023 ACT composite score was 21.3, compared to the state average of 19.3. Test prep courses are offered and online materials are available for all students.
- Class of 2024 future plans: 57% 4 year school, 18% 2 year school, 11% other college, 9% employment, 5% military.
- Through Advanced Placement classes and partnerships with Newman University, WSU Tech and Wichita State University, Eisenhower students can earn college credit before graduation.
- EHS is recognized as a Project Lead the Way Distinguished School affiliated with Wichita State University.
- Special Education Services are provided through the Goddard Special Education Cooperative. EHS houses a Mixed Abilities program for 9th-12th grade students, a Life Skills program for 9th-12th grade students, as well as hosts the TIES (Transition to Independent Employment & Success) program that provides post-secondary opportunities for students up through age 21 in a special education setting.
- EHS is fully accredited by the State of Kansas.

## RECOGNITIONS AND HONORS

- The EHS CTE Law program participates in Regional, State, and National SkillsUSA competitions. Students have taken first place at the State level in Criminal Justice & CSI which qualifies them to compete at Nationals (2019, 2022, 2023).
- BPA - Business Professionals of America: EHS students shine at state/national competitions each year with many students placing in the top 5 and top 10 in individual or team events or even earning National championship awards.
- 2023 League championships in Softball, Baseball, Boys Golf, Football, Cross Country and Unified Bowling.
- 2023 Regional championships in Football, Cross Country and Unified Bowling.
- An EHS teacher is a finalist for the Kansas Teacher of the Year Award for 2021.
- Student Council Advisor was named the 2018 Earl Reum Student Council Advisor of the Year for the state of Kansas.
- Girls Soccer achieved their 500<sup>th</sup> goal and 100<sup>th</sup> win since the school opened in 2011.
- Girls CC Team were league champs and third in State in 2018.
- Members of the EHS football team have been selected to participate in the Shrine Bowl for the last 6 years.
- Theater is a Gold Honor Thespian Troupe and we have participated at the National Speech and Debate Tournament.
- Girls and Boys Bowling Teams have won State Titles.
- Choir, Band and Orchestra members consistently receive top awards at the State Music Competitions.
- Unified Bowling and Adaptive Basketball teams allow students of all abilities to participate in athletic activities.
- EHS is recognized as a Kansas Green School of Excellence and a Department of Education Green Ribbon School.

## COLLEGE PREPARATION

### HONORS CLASSES

If eligible, students may enroll in an Honors course to be challenged beyond the average curriculum. Courses available are Honors English 9-12, Public Speaking, Honors Geometry, Honors Algebra II, Pre-Calculus, College Algebra, College Algebra with Review, AP Statistics, AP Calculus, Honors US History, Honors US Government, Honors World History, Honors Biology, Honors Chemistry I, Honors Chemistry II, Honors Chemistry III, Human Anatomy, Spanish III, German III.

### ADVANCED PLACEMENT CLASSES

Students may earn college credit by taking advanced placement classes at EHS and taking the Advanced Placement exams in May. Classes offered are AP Calculus, AP Statistics, AP Computer Science Principles and AP Studio Art.

### CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT

EHS students may participate in concurrent enrollment, receiving high school credit and college credit at the same time in a variety of different courses. Participating institutions include Newman University, WSU Tech, and Wichita State University.
