Master of Business Administration in Project Management - Minor in Biblical Business Principles

Program Description

The Master of Business Administration (MBA) in Project Management at HBI University is designed for professionals seeking advanced expertise in project planning, execution, and leadership. The program integrates business strategy, financial management, and operational efficiency with project risk analysis and team coordination to prepare graduates for executive roles.

The Minor in Biblical Business Principles offers faith-based leadership training focused on ethical decision-making, financial stewardship, and business practices grounded in biblical wisdom. Students will explore how Christian values intersect with modern business strategies and learn to apply faith-based principles to corporate and entrepreneurial ventures.

This 69-credit hour program includes 30 credit hours of foundational business and project management courses, 24 credit hours of core MBA coursework, 15 credit hours in Biblical Business Principles, elective coursework, a supervised practicum, and a research-based master's thesis.

Admissions Requirements

- Bachelor's degree in business, management, or a related field
- Minimum GPA of 3.0
- Two letters of recommendation from faculty or business professionals
- Statement of purpose outlining career goals in business, project management, and faith-based leadership
- Resume or Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- Interview with faculty committee (if required)

Practicum Requirement

Students must complete a 300-hour supervised practicum in corporate business operations, nonprofit management, or faith-based entrepreneurship. Practicum placements include church business offices, humanitarian organizations, and corporate project teams.

Master's Thesis

Students are required to complete a research-based master's thesis exploring strategic business planning, project execution, or ethical leadership in faith-based business. The thesis should provide an applied research component with real-world business case studies.

- Integrate biblical principles into business ethics, financial planning, and leadership.
