Middle School General Supply List

- Headphones or Earbuds
- Loose Leaf Paper, 2 packs of 200 sheets each
- 2 packs of multi-colored highlighters
- 24 count colored pencils

- Dry erase eraser

- Other items include any objects found around the house that may be going into the trash or recycling that you can glue and tape together. Examples include magazines, newspapers, brown paper bags, junk mail that is colorful, paint chip samples (free paper ones from Home Depot or Lowe's), beads, buttons, popsicle sticks, ribbons, felt, wire, sequins, glitter, wrapping paper, etc.

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Virtual Learning

Expectations and Recommendations

We value student participation and believe in providing a high quality educational experience. When students are prepared, they are more likely to be successful. To assist in providing this, we hold the following expectations:

1. Students participate with their cameras **on** during instruction. (from the top of the head to the shoulders)
2. Students arrive to class on time prepared to learn (*Chromebook charged, learning materials readily available; appropriately dressed*) and remain online for the duration of class.
3. Students have a space that is distraction free, safe, and supervised.
4. Parent contact information is kept up to date in ParentVue.
5. Chromebooks are frequently updated.
6. To objectively assess our students' academic growth and to remain an accredited school, in-person testing is required for a few assessments throughout the school year. These include: SOL assessments, WIDA, Special Education identification, gifted identification, and PSATs.



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
