WWP

What the objective: Convert passive social media scrollers into attendees for your upcoming friend matchmaking events in Melbourne and Sydney by driving them to book tickets via the link in your bio.

Logic/funnel:

 Instagram/TikTok Reels and Carousels → Link in bio → Event landing page → Ticket purchase

Who am I'm talking to

- Professionals aged 25-35+
- Primarily women and some men who are generally feminine and open-minded
- Living in Melbourne, Brisbane, and Sydney, Australia
- Struggling to main a social life that is enjoyable and fulfilling
 - o Busy with their corporate jobs, seeking to balance work with social enjoyment
 - Can't find anyone who they can interact with

Where are they now: on their phone scrolling and getting cheap dopamine from reels

<u>Problem to solution aware:</u> They know that they have no social interaction and want to change it – also understands that they need to go out and actually talk to people in order to start making reel friends

<u>Sophistication level 2-3:</u> Know/seen some friend making events/platforms before but never really got into it or perhaps tried it before and didn't really like it

Dream/pain state:

- Pain:
 - Spending most of their time alone, not having fun, and feeling like they aren't accepted or belonged ot any area
 - Has no social interaction that they can genuinely enjoy in their daily life
 - Noone is texting them for plans or to check on them
 - They're alone in the big city and home all the time
- Dream: Be able to enjoy their lives to the fullest, have a friend group who they can enjoy
 the company of on those quiet days whern they aren't doing anything
 - Have fun in the city and go out there to live their life

Will they buy threshold:

 Desire 3: knows that they have no friends and is numbing the pain by scrolling on Instagram – so the pain is not too pad

- Certainty 2: Relatively uncertain that if they were to talk to all the people around the street, would they even be able to make a friends (fairly uncertain that they can make friends at this point)
- Trust 0: Haven't seen the account before and therefore wouldn't trust them as much

Where do I want them to go

Will they buy levels:

- Desire: 8-9 crank this up to the moon and make them feel like they have to get friends now
- Certainty: 10 Make sure to include details about the event that shows them that it's amazing
- Trust: 9-10 Crank social proof and make sure they know that the organisers has a history of making these amazing events

How does the product fits

- Problem: Can't find people to do it with nor the place wherein they can be accepted without being judged for being a loner
- Solution: Go out their and weekend by weekend approach random people and try to get them to be your friends
- Product: Bring these accepting people together whoa re looking for a friend and help them connect

What are the steps I need to take them through in order to get them to where I want them?

- 1. Hook
 - 1. Specific frustration of the market
 - 2. Specificity + reflect current state
- 2. Introduce the product/event
 - 1. Build perceive value
 - 1. The group name's (in-group/out-group play)
 - 2. Show social proof of people exercising together
 - 2. Reveal the product
 - 1. What do they basically do every week or month
 - 2. Ideally link to a desire that the avatar would like to do in order to make friends
- 3. Showcasing the event + teasing the event + future pacing them/amplifying desire
 - 1. Show the number of people coming out to run
 - 2. "This is us warming up together
- 4. Reason for the guru for attending + relating to the current state of the avatar
 - 1. Talk about the current state of the avatar (I'm not training for a marathon)
 - 2. Talk about the desire/what the guru want that relates to the avatar (just trying to socialize and meet new people)

- 5. Emphasize/amplify the perceived value of the product
 - 1. It's so easy to achieve the desire when you're...
 - 2. Provide logical reason for why it's so easy
- 6. List the additional benefits of the event
 - 1. Being able to run on the beautiful landscape
 - 2. Enjoy a nice meal
 - 3. Fully planned event for the night

7. CTA

- 1. Come give this unique friend-making experience a try
- 2. It's a extreme friendly and cute way to meet new people, and get the rush of endorphins of interacting and actually enjoying the time you spend with people
- 3. We a social creatures and we crave that more than any dopamine hit the companies can give us

V2 Script (Game Night Promo)

Song ideas:

- Million dollar baby
- Upbeat
