HOLE DESCRIPTIONS:

- 1. Par 4 365 yards
 - Drop circle if you hit into the range on the left or water on the right (red penalty area)
 - Free relief against fence of driving range-1 club length
- 2. Par 4 340 yards
 - Water on the left could come into play on the tee shot (red penalty area)
- 3. Par 3 135 yards (red penalty area)
 - Lateral hazard behind the green
- 4. Par 4 348 yards (SPOTTER-?)
 - Woods on the right-red penalty area
 - O.B. fence line on the far left
 - Old hazard on right-2nd shot likely-play as it lies (no longer a hazard)
- 5. Par 3 138 yards
 - Old hazard on right-2nd shot likely-play as it lies (no longer a hazard)
 - REd penalty area behind the green
- 6. Par 4 295 yards
 - Woods back of the green (red penalty area)
- 7. Par 5 496 yards
 - O.B. on left-fence line
 - tree cluster on left is red penalty area
 - right & back of green (red penalty area)
- 8. Par 4 363 yards
 - Water on the left could come into play on the tee shot (red penalty area)
- 9. Par 5 450 yards
 - Water on the right-drop circle (red penalty area)
 - O.B. right of pond (#1 fairway) (ends at end of pond)
 - O.B. behind the green (cart path)
- 10. Par 4 317 yards (SPOTTER-2)
 - **Drop circle** if you hit into the range on the right or tree left (red penalty area)
 - O.B. on left-fence line
- 11. Par 4 278 yards
 - O.B. on left-fence line
- 12. Par 5 440 yards
 - Water on right, tree cluster on left-could come into play on 1st or 2nd shot (red penalty area)
 - O.B. on left-fence line
- 13. Par 4 327 yards
 - O.B. on left-fence line
 - Water-short left of the green (DROP CIRCLE-RED PENALTY AREA)
 - Metal hole cover on right-free relief, street on the right-free relief
- 14. Par 3 120 yards
- 15. Par 4 303 yards
 - O.B. on left-fence line
 - Water on the right could come into play on the tee shot (red penalty area)
- 16. Par 5 435 yards (spotter-?)
 - O.B. on far left-fence line
 - Old bunkers-? GUR-?
- 17. Par 3 139 yards
 - O.B. on left-fence line
- 18. Par 4 310 yards
 - O.B on the far left fence line
 - Water in front of the green-drop circle (red penalty area)
 - O.B. past green

- Gold tees
- Carting out holes-if you take a group out, please pick them up at the end of the round.
- USGA rules-ball is to be played as it lies. Exception- GUR (group consensus)
- 10 strokes maximum
- Play NO MOW as a RED penalty area.
 - o All no-mow hazards start with grass longer than normally maintained grass.
- If there is a doubt about the procedure, play a second ball under rule 18-3. Declare your intentions for playing a 2nd ball. Circle the hole and ask a rules person as soon as possible.
- Please take care of the course by fixing ball marks and replacing divots.
- Pace of play: Keep up with the group in front of you. If you fall behind, please catch up. We should be done and in the clubhouse in 4 ½ hours. That's 15 minutes a hole on average.
- Groups need to get together after the round to make sure hole scores are correct. Two signatures on each card and return your card to your coach. Each coach will then verify the scores.
- Range Finding Devices Range finding devices are allowed for use by players and coaches during the regular and postseason tournaments provided they are only used to measure distance. Range finding devices designed to measure conditions other than distance are permitted, PROVIDED the golfer only uses the device for distance measurement and not for the following banned functions, which include but are not limited to, wind speed, slope or club selection. A player may obtain distance information ONLY from range finding devices The penalty for violation of this rule: 1st offense warning; 2nd offense 2 stroke penalty; 3rd offense disqualification. Cell phones (including distance apps), iPods, Smartwatches and any other unapproved communication devices are not permitted to be used for communication purposes during competition. New Policy for 2022: If a player must wear a watch besides a GPS/range finding device (ex: Smartwatches, Fitbits, etc.), it must be set to airplane mode during competition. The penalty for violating this policy is as follows: 1st offense warning; 2nd offense 2 stroke penalty; 3rd offense disqualification. CELL PHONES ARE ALLOWED FOR SCORING AND RANGE FINDERS.
