Directions for Concurrent Enrollment:

To enroll in a college class on a SDCCD campus (or online) as a high school student you will need to do the following:

- Apply for the semester & year you wish to attend through <u>CCCApply</u>, and obtain a student ID number. Note: This step requires you to 1st set up a CCC Apply Account and THEN "Start a New Application"
- Once the course schedule is open for your desired term pick your class!
- Complete the "<u>Supplemental Application</u> for Special Part-Time". More
 information about the supplemental application process can be found on the
 <u>SDCCD's High School Student Webpage</u>. Please see the section titled "Take a
 College Class at City, Mesa, or Miramar College (Special Part-time)".
- Please put either Chris White (<u>cwhite@hightechhigh.org</u>) or Maribeth Brown (<u>mbrown@hightechhigh.org</u>) as your school counselor on this form (we will approve the course before Mesa Admissions can enroll you).
- The SD Mesa Admissions team will manually enroll you for courses during open enrollment if there is space in the class. If there is no space, they will add you to the waitlist. You can see the admissions deadline, including when open enrollment begins here (Links to an external site).
- High school students taking classes on Mesa's campus are responsible for the \$22 student health fee and representation fee.
- All fees must be paid before being able to purchase a parking pass for the semester.
