Station 1: MANDATORY - Student Card Table – Inside Door 1: Pick up your student card that will walk you through each station provided you have completed your online residency/registration in Parent View prior to August 9th. **THESE CARDS MUST BE SIGNED AND COLLECTED AT THE LAST STATION; PLEASE DO NOT TAKE THEM HOME WITH YOU.**

Room F100 – Residency/Registration Room – If you do not receive a card at Station 1 you will need to see Guidance here to prove residency or determine why your online registration is not completed. You will not receive your card to proceed if residency is not verified. A parent will need to be present if you need to complete this step. Please complete this online prior to arriving at school for this event in your Parent View account starting May 1st when Online Registration Opens.

Station 2: MANDATORY: Nurse – All students: Check point to be sure all documents have been submitted/received. Please upload your documents into your ParentVue prior to coming or email them to the nurses' office at erica_patterson@ipsd.org to save time. You may drop off any health/physical records, sports physicals, **9th grade physicals, Immunizations, Dental, Eye Examines and/or Senior Meningitis** vaccination, but please keep a copy for yourself as well. You may drop off medicine related forms, if needed, also.

Station 3: English Novel Studies OPTIONAL – Book Fair: Auditorium Concession Window – Purchase your own novels for English class so that you may keep them, write, highlight, take notes in them – Cash & Checks only.

Station 4: MANDATORY: School ID/Yearbook Pictures– Cafeteria: There will be multiple photographers working to quickly process students through the photographs. All students, 9th – 12th Grade, must take a photo, regardless of purchasing pictures or a yearbook for your new Student ID. **SENIORS, yes, you must have an ID photo taken because it will also be used as your YEARBOOK PHOTO.** **All students need to stop at this station as this will also be your yearbook photo.** Please dress accordingly.
