The **Central National Road** was commissioned by the 8th Congress of the Republic of Texas on February 5, 1844 to connect the Red River in northeast Texas to existing military roads along the Trinity River. The exact route passed through the present counties of Dallas, Rockwall, Collin, Hunt, Fannin, Lamar and Red River. Starting below the Elm Fork of the Trinity River at a small trading post and ferry crossing run by John Neely Bryan, this road originated near the center of what is now Dallas. Without this road North Texas might look a lot different today.
