It is imperative now, more than ever, for our nation's public schools to invest in World Language experiences for elementary-aged children. Our school district recently expanded five World Languages options into 6th grade to complement our International Baccalaureate - Middle Years Program initiative. This past year, we implemented a *Foreign Language Elementary School* (FLES) program in Spanish for all 2nd and 3rd graders, adding a 4th grade component in 2018-19. The children are immersed in the Spanish language and culture for 30 minutes, every-other-day. It is our hope to establish a FLES continuum through 5th grade next year. Our vision is to prepare all students to meet current and future challenges and become productive members of a diverse global community.

I am humbled to be the recipient of 2018 NNELL Award for Outstanding Support of Early Second Language Learning. However, I firmly believe this recognition is more a reflection of the Pelham community, parents, teachers, administrators, and Board of Education rather than any individual effort.
