



Terms and Conditions

1. Funding is subject to the availability of funds at the time of application.
2. Applicants are required to be fully registered with Jamboree and, if they are a Scout, to be part of a Troop.
3. Applications may be made either by a Leader or a family member of the young person. Venturers may complete the application form themselves.

If the applicant's parent is a Leader, another Leader should apply, preferably the Group or Zone Leader.

4. In most cases, only one application per Scout Group will be accepted in each funding round. Please check with the Group prior to applying. Total funding to groups will be capped based on the Deprivation Index of the Group and Zone.
5. If more than one application from a Group ends up in the same funding round, the Group will be required to rank the applications. This situation could arise when applications have missed the close-off of one round and been deferred to the next.
6. In the case of a Scout recipient, Grant funding will only be paid to Troops once assurance has been received that a minimum of the deposit is paid.

In the case of a Venturer recipient, the grant funding will be credited against their fee owing by the Jamboree Team, once a minimum deposit is received from the Venturer.

7. Refunds and cancellations are subject to the Jamboree Refunds and Cancellation policy. If the Applicant withdraws for any reason, or the event is cancelled, funds provided as a Jamboree Grant will be returned to the Grant pool immediately.
8. Applicants may be required to supply feedback after the event and will be required to agree to this at the time of accepting the grant. We may contact you after the Jamboree seeking brief feedback on what you gained from the event. This feedback is valuable and will assist future Scouts and Venturers to access similar funding.
9. Should the grant recipient achieve alternative funding after the grant has been awarded, notification and return, or part return, of the funds would be appreciated so that others in need can benefit from these funds.
