Have them draw what they found and label all 8 shapes (you may help spell).
Rainbow write 10 sight words. You can write each letter a different color, the word a different color, or mystery write the words using a white crayon and coloring over to reveal the word. Send in your work. (the, I, and, a, is, as, to, do, of, see, be, me, from, look, book, are, you, what, have, said)	Complete the attached addition worksheet.
Read a book of your choice and focus on the parts of the story. Draw a picture of the character, setting and a big event. Write the title of the book and label the best you can.	Get Active!!
