Dear Future Seventh Grade Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

It is course selection time for the upcoming school year! We will be meeting with your student's class to discuss next year's required and elective course opportunities. The different subject area course formats of Core/Academic and Advanced were reviewed. Courses designated as Advanced prepare students for Advanced Placement courses (college level instruction) while in high school. Each student was shown how to access the [Georgetown ISD Secondary Course Guide](#) and the [2025-2026 Middle School Advising Guide](#) online. Your student should explore course options and seek your assistance in making informed choices about courses that will best meet his or her educational needs.

With your student, please discuss and review their course options for the 2025-2026 school year. If you are unsure about the best placement for your student, contact his/her current subject area teacher. Students often enroll in a combination of course formats (advanced and on level). Georgetown ISD has established guidelines to assist parents and students as they consider course requests for the upcoming school year. Your student should request the following courses: ELAR (English/Language Arts/Reading), Social Studies, Science, P.E./athletics, and two electives. We will add math courses based on what your student's math class was this year. After making the course selections, please be sure that all course guidelines have been reviewed and course selections have been made based upon your student's individual academic strengths, interests, and commitment.

Wagner counselors will be visiting 6th grade social studies classes on January 30th & January 31st to help the students complete their course selection using skyward. Later this spring, your student will receive a course verification sheet that you may use to review course placement for the 25-26 school year. If your student changes their mind about their course requests, they will need to wait until the course verification process to formally request a change. After the course verification process, very few schedule changes will be considered.
