By submitting my 2026 *Digital Games Pathway Program* application form, I agree to be bound by the following terms and conditions:

1. I understand that I need to be a current Screenworks member that has been living in regional NSW for more than 6 months, and be an Australian citizen or permanent resident.
2. I understand and agree that Screenworks will forward my application to an independent assessment panel to assess my suitability to participate in the 2026 *Digital Games Pathway Program*.
3. If selected for the 2025 *Digital Games Pathway Program* I understand and agree to be interviewed, photographed or recorded during any part of the program. Any such recording, photograph or interview may be used across any media format for promotional and/or reporting purposes. I agree to tag Screenworks and the program partners in any social media posts I may create.
4. If selected for the 2026 *Digital Games Pathway Program* I agree to finesse my Career Plan in consultation with Screenworks. I understand that the career plan will be subject to approval by Screenworks and the relevant state funding body.
5. I agree that, if successful with this application, I will be available (or will make myself available) to take part in the *Digital Games Pathway Program* between May 2026 and May 2027.
6. If selected for the 2026 *Digital Games Pathway Program* I understand and agree that I will submit a final report at the end of the program.
