Summary of Prescription Drug Coverage

What are the copays for prescription drugs?

Covered person's co-pay amount for up to a 30-day supply are the same for health insurance plan:

- Tier 1 (Generic and Some Brand-Name) =\$10
- Tier 2 (Generic and Preferred Brand-Name) = \$30
- Tier 3 (Non Preferred Brand-Name and Non Preferred Generic) = \$45

How many times can I refill a prescription at a retail pharmacy?

After two retail maintenance medication fills, mail service is required at $2 \frac{1}{2}$ times copay for a 90-day supply:

- Tier 1 (Generic and Some Brand-Name) = \$25
- Tier 2 (Generic and Preferred Brand-Name) = \$45
- Tier 3 (Non Preferred Brand-Name and Non Preferred Generic) = \$112.50

What are the Out of Pocket Maximums for prescription drugs?

Annual Pharmacy Out-Of-Pocket Maximum Per Calendar Year:

- Per Person = \$3,600
- Per Family = \$4,200
