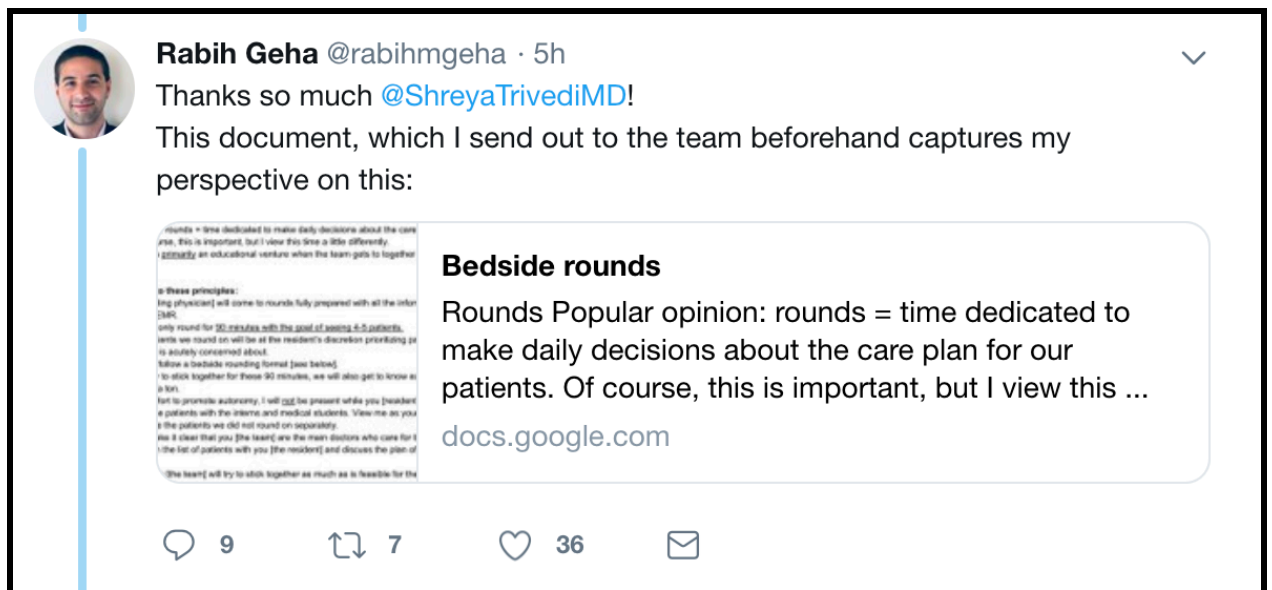
Exercise 0 - Twitter Start-up Instructions

Exercise 1 - How can social media make you a better doctor/teacher (or simply teach you something you did not know)?

1. Share your experience (if any) learning from social media
