"When you look at the boats coming across the English Channel filled with migrants wanting to relocate here. Lots say they are coming from a dangerous country and need safe refuge. Yet most of these boats are coming from France, which to my knowledge is a safe country. Ok the desire to relocate here is strong, but should our partners on mainland Europe be doing more for these people and not dumping the issue on us? Surely there is a national security alert to be called as people who want to cause our culture serious harm are now getting in and mixing amongst us? Also, there are different laws across Europe that allow this movement to occur. For example, many of the boats come from Turkey, and are stored in west Germany. Close to the channel but not to close. In Germany there is a loophole in the law that says, it's not illegal for people to transport people out of an EU state (France) into a third party state (England). The only way we can resolve this is to work with all states, but then again, this migration is only the start. Mass migration will really start when global warming really drives on".
