I. Introduction

A journal article introduction should clearly and concisely explain the research topic, its significance, and why the study was undertaken. It should also provide a brief overview of the research methods and findings. A well-written introduction guides the reader, establishing the context for the rest of the paper.

II. Theoretical Framework

A theoretical framework consists of concepts, together with their definitions, and existing theory/theories that are used for your study. The theoretical framework must demonstrate an understanding of theories and concepts that are relevant to the topic of your research paper and that will relate it to the broader fields of knowledge in the class you are taking.

The theoretical framework is not something that is readily available in literature. You must review course readings and pertinent research literature for theories and analytic models that are relevant to the research problem you are investigating. The selection of a theory should depend on its appropriateness, ease of application, and explanatory power.
