- 5:00pm-6:15pm **Dinner and Body (of Christ) Bag opening.** “Body Bags” are explained below. A dinner suggestion is to build a fire and roast hotdogs and smores.
- 6:30pm **Worship.** A link to view the virtual worship service will be provided at a later date. The idea is to gather around a fire for worship if possible and view the service on a projector and screen or individual devices. If your group is not able to have a fire on your church grounds, perhaps a parent or leader could host the event.

You are encouraged to continue group discussion around the fire after worship.
