Project requirements

- The topic of each project should reflect the essence of one of the EU's key values
- The format is an English language lesson in a secondary school (please, indicate the age group of students)
- The venue is Zoom platform
- Presentation time is up to 20 minutes

- The language of the presentation is English
- Adherence to the rules of academic integrity (scientific basis of the project, list of references, references to online resources that are properly formatted)
- Use of various digital services, platforms and applications
- Proper visualisation of the project presentation using logos, templates and disclaimers of the Jean Monnet Module
- Equal contribution of each project team member to the preparation and presentation of the project
- Mandatory participation in the discussion of other teams' projects

Group project evaluation criteria (10 points)

- Relevance of the project topic to the content of the EU core values (1 point)
- Relevance of the project material to the age group of secondary school students (1 point)
- Adherence to the timing of the presentation (up to 20 minutes) (1 point)
- Compliance with the requirements for the language of presentation (English) (1 point)
- Scientific basis of the project (1 point)
- Adherence to the rules of academic integrity (properly formatted list of references, links to online resources, used photo and video materials) (1 point)
- Use of various digital services, platforms, applications (1 point)
- Proper visualisation of the project presentation (using logos, templates and disclaimer of the Jean Monnet Module) (1 point)
- Equal contribution of each project team member to the preparation and presentation of the project (1 point)
- Active participation of all team members in the discussion of other teams' projects (1 point)
