

# MASS ECAN MEMBER SURVEY SUMMARY

Activities & Resources, Attendance & Connectivity, and Value of Mass ECAN Work Groups



#### Introduction

In summer of 2021, we conducted our first ever Mass ECAN member online survey. With 41 responses, the survey yielded overwhelmingly positive responses to our core responsibilities and resources. We also received valuable feedback on where we can improve and what to work on next.

For example, members want to see more:

- Suggestions regarding funding
- Documentation of Mass ECAN accomplishments
- Work Group updates
- Project photos, video content and multimedia
- Organizational spotlights

#### Highlights from results:

- 90% of respondents are somewhat or very satisfied with their Mass ECAN experience
- 90% of respondents read at least the majority of newsletters, 44% read all
- 90% of respondents reported that Mass ECAN was somewhat or very effective at providing access to information, resources and talking points (10% unsure)
- 83% of respondents reported that Mass ECAN was somewhat or very effective at facilitating knowledge sharing and collaboration (17% unsure)
- Most respondents have attended Mass ECAN programs
- Nearly all respondents reported that Mass ECAN has facilitated a connection to a new colleague




## Overall, how satisfied are you with your experience with Mass ECAN?


## How often do you read our monthly Mass ECAN newsletters?





## Have you attended previous Mass ECAN events?






In your opinion, how effective is Mass ECAN at facilitating knowledge sharing and collaboration among practitioners?




How effective is Mass ECAN at providing you access to information, resources, and talking points that you can use in your climate adaptation planning and practice?




In your opinion, how effective is Mass ECAN at advancing the field of climate adaptation? 41 responses



How often are ecosystems/natural systems considered in the climate adaptation conversations you are part of?





## Are you a member of a Mass ECAN affiliated Work Group?




How satisfied are you with the work group(s) that you have participated in? <sup>20 responses</sup>
