## **OUR COMMUNITY**

Bonny Eagle High School in Maine School Administrative District 6 serves approximately 1,150 students in grades 9-12 from the rural towns of Buxton, Frye Island, Hollis, Limington, and Standish. Bonny Eagle is a member of the Southern Maine Partnership and is accredited by Maine's Department of Education and Cultural Services and the New England Association of Schools and Colleges. MSAD 6 is located approximately 20 miles northwest of Portland. We are one of the largest MSADs in the state with a population of over 3,800 students attending our high school, middle school, and six elementary schools.

BEHS uses a Proficiency Based Education model for grading and scoring content indicators by standards. Student learning of these standards are measured using summative assessments, which are scored only on course content comprehension. Summative assessments account for 80% of the student's course grade. Student work completion and meeting established deadlines account for the remaining 20% of the final grade. The final transcript grade is converted to an alpha grade. However, the GPA is reported as an average of all course grades on the 1-4 standards scale. Students must receive a 2.7 or higher in order to earn credit for a course. If they earn below a 2.0, they will receive an NC (no credit - repeat course). If remediation is recommended to complete/finish a course, a score below 2.7 may appear on the transcript and include credit.

### CURRICULUM

All core courses are college preparatory with the exception of Physical Science A and B, Honors (15) or Advanced Placement (14) courses. Weighted grades are calculated as follows on a 4.0 scale. .2 additional points for Pre-Approved College Courses, Pre-Approved Technical Programs and Honors Classes. .4 additional points for Advanced Placement Courses.
