Open Seats: Election 2026

Position	Term	Salary	Filing Fee	Requirements
U.S. Senate	6 years	\$174,000	\$1,740	30 years of age. Nine-year citizen of the U.S. WV inhabitant when elected.
U.S. House of Representatives – 2nd District	2 years	\$174,000	\$1,740	25 years of age. Seven-year citizen of the U.S. WV inhabitant when elected.
West Virginia State Senate – District 15	4 years	\$20,000	\$200	25 years of age. Citizen of WV for 5 years. Resident of district or county 1 year prior to election.
West Virginia House of Delegates - Districts 89 or 90	2 years	\$20,000	\$100	18 years of age. Resident of district or county 1 year prior to election.
Morgan County Commission – Magisterial Districts 1,2,5	6 years	\$43,909	\$440	18 years of age. Resident of precinct 1, 2, or 5.
Morgan County Board of Education*	4 years	\$260/meeting	\$25	18 years of age. High school diploma or GED.
Conservation District Supervisor*	4 years	\$0	\$10	Landowner in district.
Magistrate Judge – Division 2*	2 years**	\$63,250	\$633	21 years of age. High school diploma or GED. Not convicted of any felonies or misdemeanors involving moral turpitude.

* These seats are non-partisan. All others must declare party affiliation.

** Magistrate Judge is typically a 4-year term. Following the resignation of the elected Magistrate and appointment of the current incumbent, this election is to fill the remaining 2 years of the 2026-2028 term. This seat will be up for re-election in 2028 for a 4-year term.

The filing period is January 12- 31, 2026.

Position	Term	Salary	Filing Fee	Requirements
State Executive Committee* - Senate District 15	4 years	\$0	\$20	Two men and two women may be elected from Senate District 15. No more than two committee members can be elected from the same county.
Congressional Executive Committee – 2nd District	4 years	\$0	\$5	One man and one woman from Morgan County may be elected to the 2 nd District Committee.
Morgan County Executive Committee	4 years	\$0	\$10	One man and one woman may be elected from each of Morgan County's five Magisterial Districts.

* State Executive Committee candidates file with the West Virginia Secretary of State. All other executive committee candidates file with the Morgan County Clerk.

The filing period is January 12- 31, 2026.
