It is the intent of Bullard High School to conduct a graduation ceremony that reflects the dignity of our school and community. While it is an individual accomplishment, graduation is a celebration shared by classmates, families, friends, and community members. Therefore, the ceremony will maintain an orderly and positive atmosphere. Any disruptive action is not permitted.

All BHS graduation candidates who desire to participate in the ceremony will adhere to the following dress code:

- Ladies: dress pantsuit or dress, dress shoes
 - o No casual sandals, flip flops, stiletto heels, athletic shoes, or boots
 - No shorts
- <u>Gentlemen</u>: slacks, collared shirt, starched (no holes or frays) denim jeans, dress shoes or dress boots
 - No athletic shoes or flip flops
 - Gentlemen are encouraged to wear a dress shirt and tie
 - No shorts
- Caps and gowns will not be altered (example: no personalization)
- Only cords, stoles, and medals issued and approved by BHS programs are permitted.

Graduation candidates are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful and dignified manner. If individuals choose to behave otherwise, they will be removed from the line or ceremony. Diplomas could be held pending any disruptive behavior. Any suspicion or alcohol or drugs will result in removal of the candidate.
