THE SECRET HAS BEEN SOLVED!

Turn in the Phoenix Ash Talisman, 20 <u>Ash Feathers</u> (Griftah necklace), and 15 <u>Smoldering Phoenix Ashes</u> (rare drop from DF phoenixes) in to Tarjin the Blind in the Waking Shores (/way 16.13, 62.6) to receive the Phoenix Wishwing pet.

INTRO

UPDATE 3/28/23: The ember drops from Timewalking Alysrazor! It appears it drops for all members of the raid regardless of how many ash items they possess.

THE NEXT CATACLYSM TIMEWALKING WILL NOT BE UNTIL MAY 23rd

We are now currently looking for what the Phoenix Ash Talisman does!



UPDATE 12/12/22 - the ash now stacks!

UPDATE 12/20/22 - Blizzard releases a new storebought transmog set called "Fireplume Regalia"

UPDATE 2/1/23 - on the 10.0.7 PTR the amulet buff no longer gets removed if you click on it in your bags while it is on CD, this has not been fixed on live yet. Feathers still spawn outside of the Waking Shores

UPDATE 2/12/23 - the <u>Crimson Phoenix Hatchling</u> and <u>Blue Phoenix Hatchling</u> (added in 10.0) have been renamed to Ashenwing and Wakyn respectively on the 10.0.7 PTR. Their movesets

have also been changed from the generic phoenix moveset.



This regalia has no interactable parts like the SL worm mount did, nor does it appear to have any interaction with the ash feathers, dying, or Zektar.

UPDATE 3/28/23: The glittering phoenix ember has been found to drop from timewalking Alysrazor in the Firelands.

Farming the Talisman

Sacred Phoenix Ash:



This ash is lootable from <u>Small Piles of Ash</u> pots in Spires of Arak, and requires level 60 in order to pick it up. The ash has multiple spawns and a fairly short respawn timer, and we need ten of them to purchase the item from Zektar. Here are some waypoints of spawn locations:

The ash piles will also show up on your minimap if you use the <u>Scavenger's Eyepiece</u> item (chance to appear when using the Smuggling Run ability from the zone outpost, once every 10 minutes)




Inert Phoenix Ash:



This ash has a low drop rate (estimated about 3%) from only the <u>Scorching Elementals</u> found around Fire Plume Ridge in Un'goro crater. The Scorching Elementals share a spawn with the nearby Living Blazes so you'll want to kill them as well. The 20 you need for the talisman will take you anywhere from 2.5 - 4+ hours of farming, so I highly recommend getting this done before this secret becomes common knowledge and people start farming.

Glittering Phoenix Ember:



What appears to be a guaranteed drop from Alysrazor in Timewalking Firelands - this means this item is only available every x weeks a year.



All three items get turned into Zektar in Spires of Arak to buy the Phoenix Ash Talisman (NOTE: if you can't find Zektar you must first complete the quest chain starting with "Cult of the Ravenspeakers" and ending with "The High Ravenspeaker")





THE GLITTERING EMBER

THEORIES:

- 1.) drops from a mob in legacy content, but has such a low drop rate that no one has reported it yet
- 2.) drops from a mob in legacy content, but requires something to happen before it can drop (clicking something, wearing a Griftah neck, etc)
- 3.) lootable item from some non mob object
- 4.) drops from a mob in the Dragon Isles
- 5.) bought from some unknown vendor
- 6.) reward from pet battling

(for future reference: buff you get from completing the dungeon meta achievement in Nokhud)



WHAT IS A BIRD OF FLAME?

There are three types of entities in this game that could be counted as "a bird that is also on fire":

- 1.) Phoenixes, a type of fire elemental summoned by mages https://wowpedia.fandom.com/wiki/Phoenix
- Firehawks (one word), regular beasts spawned by the goddess Ruhkmar on alternate Draenor

- 3.) Fire hawks (two words), wild creatures that inhabit the Plane of Fire, also includes the flight forms of druids of flame and Alysrazor, who used to be a green dragon https://wowpedia.fandom.com/wiki/Fire_hawk
- 4.) Tinfoil hat theory time: a dragon or a regular bird that is literally on fire (ex. Chi-Ji, etc)

PHOENIX LOCATIONS

- Al'ar boss of Tempest Keep, also potentially Kael'thas' mount in the Shadowlands but as a ghost?
- Blazewing rare mob that spawns in Hyjal
- Reborn Phoenix mob that spawns during the Sun King's Salvation fight in Castle Nathria
- Depleted Phoenix/Energized Phoenix mobs that spawn during the Ruhkmar world boss fight (these may technically count as firehawks)
- Phoenix part of the Kael'thas fight in both Tempest Keep and Magister's Terrace
- Phoenix Hatchling battle pet
- Can be found in random places, also associated with blood elves




- Makhra the Ashtouched, rare elite in Nokhudon Hold (2.2m HP)

DARK PHOENIXES

(A type of phoenix born from the shadows after a regular phoenix hatches)

- Harbinger of Darkness summoned by High Prophet Barim in Lost City of Tol'vir when he hits 50% HP
- Dark Phoenix Hatchling battle pet

FIRE HAWK (two words) LOCATIONS

- Rukhmar world boss in Spires of Arak
- Rukhran boss in Skyreach
- General Spires of Arak zone

- - Blazing Dreadsqualls in northern Waking Shores



- Some trash mobs in Neltharus

FIREHAWK (one word) LOCATIONS

- Multiple trash mobs in the Molten Front and Firelands raid
- Found in the Hyjal section of Deaths of Chromie
- Alysrazor boss in Firelands
- Millagazor, daily quest mob in Hyjal
- Andrazor, daily quest mob in Hyjal

GRIF'TAH AMULET

In the Waking Shores Grif'tah sells the Ash Feather Amulet https://www.wowhead.com/beta/item=199177/ash-feather-amulet



Wearing it allows you to see and collect Ash Feathers (which are currently bugged to be spawning anywhere), the use for these Ash Feathers is currently unknown.



The buff from this necklace stays on even when dead, and feathers are able to be collected while dead. Something peculiar to note is that feathers collected in the "intended" area of the Slagmire have the NPC ID of 199442, while "bugged" feathers collected elsewhere have the NPC ID of 195759. The bottom screenshot shows two feathers with two different NPC IDs spawning a few yards apart from each other (in the Slagmire, a few yards north of the rare elite lava worm).



Here's a map from Walozdle showing 20 fixed spawn points for the 442 ID feathers:



Also noteworthy is the Smoldering Phoenix Ash that drops from Lava Phoenixes in the Waking Shores




And potentially the Phoenix Stone as well

"Obtained from a firebird years and moments after its end."



Chinese (source: Sappheiros):

"a bird of flame fallen for many years, it was obtained from the remains a few seconds after the fall"



Korean (source: Theis):

"It's been reaped many years since the firebird met its end."



Italian (source: nuked)

"Taken from the fire bird fallen few moments after his death"
