### Theme Requirements

To use Natix Host, make sure your **hosting provider** is running the following software:

- 1.WordPress 4.8 or higher.
- 2. My SQL 5.6 or greater.
- 3. PHP 5.6 or greater. Wordpress officially suggests using PHP 7.2.

#### Recommended PHP Limits

Many issues that you may run into such as: white screen, demo content fails when importing, empty page content and other similar issues are all related to low PHP configuration limits. The solution is to **increase the PHP limits**. You can do this on your own, or **contact your web host** and ask them to increase those limits to a minimum as follows:

- max\_execution\_time 300
- memory limit 128M

- post max size 64M
- upload max filesize 32M
- max input time = 60
- max input vars = 3000

Also consider upgrading your PHP Version to the latest version, the newer the better.

#### WordPress Information

To install this theme you must have a working version of WordPress already installed. If you need help installing WordPress, follow the instructions in WordPress Codex or you can watch the useful links below for WordPress information.

#### What's Included

When you purchase our theme from Themeforest, you need to download the Natix-Host files from your Themeforest account. Navigate to your downloads tab on Themeforest and find Natix-Host. Click the download button to see the two options. The **Main Files** contain everything, the **Installable WordPress Theme** is just the installable WordPress theme file. Below is a full list of everything that is included when you download the main files, along with a brief description of each item.


- **Installable WordPress file only**. You can upload this file when you install the theme.
- All files and documentation (full zip folder). You will need to extract and locate the installable WordPress file to upload when you install the theme.




#### Theme Installation

It's easy to **install Natix-Host.** Just follow these steps, they won't take much of your time.

- 1. Download the theme zip file from your **Envato account** from ThemeForest.
- 2. \*\*All files & documentation \*\*(full zip folder). You will need to extract and locate the installable WordPress file to upload when installing the theme.
- 3. Log in to your WordPress **Dashboard** (Ex: <a href="http://yourwebsite.com/wp-admin">http://yourwebsite.com/wp-admin</a>).
- 4. Navigate to Appearance > Themes.

- 5. Click on Add New and then Click on Upload Theme .
- 6. Click Add New, then click Upload Theme > Choose File.
- 7. Navigate to the .zip file on your computer, then click Install Now.
- 8. When the installation completes, click **Activate**. You will be redirected to Themes page with Natix-Host activated.







#### 9. **Done**.

#### Install theme via FTP

To manually upload your new WordPress theme, login with your credentials to your website and locate the wp-content folder in your WordPress install files. Upload the **un-zipped** 'natix' folder into the: wp-content/themes folder.


Once uploaded, activate the theme by heading to the "Themes" menu in the WordPress Dashboard. Locate the Natix-Host theme and hit "Activate".

The theme files will be stored on your server in the wp-content/themes/ location.

Note: When uploading your theme with the installer, please ensure you are uploading the theme .zip file, not the entire package you downloaded. In this case, you will be uploading Natix-Host.zip.


# Plugin Installation

After activating Natix-Host, you will see this notice:





Click **Begin installing plugins**. You will be navigated to the **Install Required Plugins** page.


Simply check all of them (or all of the required plugins and some recommended plugins you like) and from the drop down select **Install**, then hit **Apply**.




### When finishing, it should look like this:











### **Demo Installation**





Step 1: Navigate to Pages in your admin sidebar and click Add New option.




**Step 2:** Enter a new name for your page, then find the **Page Attributes** box on the right side to set your **Parent** or **Template** page.





# Use Elementor to Build Page

**Step 1:** Choose **Edit With Elementor** to edit your page.




**Step 2:** Choose **Add Element** to start adding our premade elements to your new page.




















### Retina Logos

Retina versions are twice as large as the original ones. For example, if your logo is 100px x 50px, the Retina version must be 200px x 100px.




### Navigation & Menus


1.Go to **Appearance** → **Menus** in your admin sidebar and click **Create a new menu** option..




2. Select **Create a new menu** at the top of the page




3. Choose menu items you want to add from the left and hit **Add to Menu**. Then hit **Save Menu**.



Step 1: Appearance >> Widgets. You can see all of the Sidebar here.


**Step 2:** Choose the **Widgets** you want and drag it to the **Sidebar** you want or click on it to choose the **Sidebar**.


In the case you want to delete its settings, drag it back.

Hit Appearance > Widgets. Choose a widget you want to edit.






Then go to the right where you will notice a just-added widget. In this case, **Search on Footer|#2**. Type information and hit **Save**.




