## Sample Quote that I Found:

"It is important in San Diego and U.S. history, not solely because it occurred but because the community took court action and won the case they <u>established the rights of their children to equal education</u>, <u>despite local</u>, <u>regional and national sentiment that favored</u> not only segregation, but the actual deportation of the Mexican population in the United States."

Now, this quote is TOO big, I don't want to use all of it, so I am going to select the piece that I feel is most important.

The Lemon Grove Incident verdict demonstrated that Mexican Americans were unwilling to sacrifice their children's rights, the case "established the rights of their children to equal education, despite local, and regional and national resentment that favored...segregation" (Espinoza, 1986). While the court case was won by Mexican Americans, national attitudes toward segregation disliked the verdict. The general public wanted segregation. SUMMARY. The American public

needed more than a court case, they needed help teaching people how to end racism. This was a complex task, because people had been racist since the founding of the nation and immigrants were merely used as a scapegoat. ANALYSIS
