One Day Academy Exists to:

- Strengthen parents in Christian training, mentoring, and disciplining their children.
- Promote a safe environment where academic learning is encouraged and Godly character is admired.
- Equip students with thorough, academic learning for college-level academics and expectations.
- Model Christ's example, fellowship and guidance to support young people through campus faculty, and supervisors.
- Extend friendship, guidance, and support through communities of like-minded individuals who hold the church in high regard and appreciate its generosity in allowing us to use their property.

Campus Hours:

- Bryan/College Station campuses open at 8:00 a.m. and close at 4:30 p.m.
- Students may help set up campus starting at 8 AM to earn volunteer hours.
- Students keep track of their community service hours in the community service log for a certificate at the end of the year.

General Policies:

- Students need to enter and exit through the door by the green awning on E. 27th St.
- Students and visitors are required to sign in and out as they enter and as they exit.
- Students need to park in the parking lot across the street from the green awning or next to the playground. Students should not park in church staff parking or by the church office gate closest to the playground.
- Students may only exit and enter through the faculty doors when helping a teacher or if there is an emergency (such as fire, tornado, etc.).
- Students are permitted to enter their class 5 minutes before it starts but not earlier.
- Students should not "hang-out" in classrooms with teachers unless for tutoring purposes, or loiter in stairwells or in hallways.
- Supervised areas are provided, both a break room and a quiet study room, so that students may remain on campus between classes to work on school subjects or visit with friends.. The break room is where students may eat lunch, play board games, cards, etc. We do not permit ball playing or rough housing indoors. Students should stay in these designated and supervised areas when not in class.
- All Students will be escorted by an adult from the playground to the building and vice versa.
- We have a wonderful playground and gaga pit where we can take the kids on break. Activities to refrain from: gymnastics, tackle football (flag permitted), wrestling, and rock throwing (even on the slide).
- Please **pick up students** within an hour of finishing class for the day. Our campus closes promptly at 4:30 pm.
- Students are only allowed to use earbuds in the quiet room while working on schoolwork.
- Please do not disrupt church offices, classes, or others.
- **No wheels on campus.** For the safety of students, please keep all skateboards, roller skates, roller blades, and wheelies at home.
- **Teen drivers** may not drive a motor vehicle with more than one passenger in the car under 21 who is not a family member per Texas state law.

- Students cannot use the kitchens, or vending machines.
- The elevator is only for supervised use in case of a physical disability - no regular use is permitted
- Students should clean-up their spaces and dispose of all trash when leaving their seat at the table. No food, drink or other trash should be left on the tables.
- Please no food delivery while on campus.
- For their safety, students may leave campus in a vehicle only. No walk-offs are allowed.

Visitors:

- ALL campus visitors must sign-in and sign-out with the supervisors and wear a visitor lanyard while on campus.

Tuition:

- Please recognize that courses meet for the entire academic year. While other programs often ask for tuition in full at the beginning of the year, ODA Faculty allow tuition payments over our 9 month academic year. Tuition is due on the first day of the month, Aug/September-May. Please note that Aug/Sept is considered a combined first month for tuition purposes, so your 2nd tuition payment will be due Oct 1st.

Dress Code:

- Students must follow the ODA dress code found in the [ODA Policies 2025-26](#).
- Also, please refrain from wearing pajamas, pajama pants, or slippers. Students should be in suitable attire for daily activities.
- Footwear must be worn at all times, inside and outside.

Electronics:

- Students need to be respectful to Supervisors when asked about electronic devices.
- **All electronic devices will be put away and not visible.**
- Cell phones can be used only in front of a supervisor at a supervisor desk should the student need to text or call parents.
- Texting and video recording are prohibited during campus hours (0800-1630).
- Students may only use electronic devices while actively working on schoolwork at the designated Electronics Tables or in the Quiet Study Room.
- Students may not use cell phones/electronics while socializing outside or on the playground.
- Students may only have cell phones/electronics out during class if a medical emergency exists or if this has been approved with the instructor for academic purposes.
- Students may only use headphones/earbuds for academic purposes while in the quiet study room.
- Students may not share screens OR headphones/earbuds with other students.
- Students may not bring gaming devices; this includes DS, Nintendo Switch, etc...
- As indicated in [ODA Policies](#), if the policy is not followed, electronic devices will be confiscated until the end of the day.

Consequences:

- Any phone/electronic in view will be taken, logged, and securely held until the end of the day when the student or parent can collect it.
 - First offense, the electronic will be returned to the student.
 - Second offense, a parent will need to come inside and retrieve the electronic, and there will be an official ODA warning written.
 - Third offense, a parent will retrieve the electronic from the Regional Director or Lead Supervisor, and there will be an official ODA write-up.

- Subsequent offenses will follow the discipline procedures in the ODA Policy.
