ABSTRACT (English)

The abstract text should be formatted using 10-point Times or Constantia and indented 25 mm from the left margin. Leave 10 mm space after the abstract before you begin the main text of your article, starting on the same page as the abstract. The abstract should give readers concise information about the content of the article and indicate the main results obtained and conclusions drawn. The abstract is not part of the text and should be complete in itself; no table numbers, figure numbers, references or displayed mathematical expressions should be included. It should be suitable for direct inclusion in abstracting services and should not normally exceed 200 words in a single paragraph. Since contemporary information-retrieval systems rely heavily on the content of titles and abstracts to identify relevant articles in literature searches, great care should be taken in constructing both.

The manuscript written with 5-20 pages. **At least 30 reference used to present introductions.** References use at least last 5 years of articles, books or other resources

In the second paragraph and so on given 1 cm indentation. Second and third headings written with following the format provided.

Second Level

2. Methods (11pt, bold, Uppercase)

In the methods section, explained about subject/participant, procedure of studies, the material/instrument, and data analysis. It can be written by using subheading with 3 level maximum.

2.2 Participant

Use description and table to present the detail or characteristic of participants.

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2.3 Material

Present the instrumen including name of instrumen, indicators in table, also description of the instrumen.

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2.4 Procedure

Present step by step of the research.

2.5 Data Analysis

Present step by step of the data analysis.

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3. Results (11pt, bold, Uppercase)

In this section, explained about results of the present study. Use Constantia 11pt, single space, no space between paragraph.

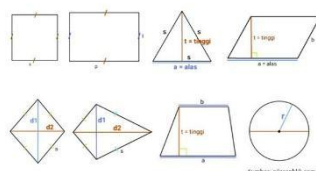


FIGURE 1. Sentence case, *Constantia 10 pt italic***TABLE 1.** Sentence case, *Constantia 10 pt italic*

In the second paragraph and so on given 1 cm indentation. Second and third headings written with following the format provided. The format of mention of images and tables in paragraphs are **FIGURE 1** and **TABLE 1** (Bold, start at 1). Figure presented by jpeg or png format (Constantia 10pt).

5. Conclusion (11pt, bold, Uppercase)

The concluding statement should contain summary and suggestion. The summary should exemplify the answers provided to the hypothesis and/or research objectives or acquired findings. The summary should not contain repetition of research results and discussions, and it should instead contain a summation of research results and findings as expected in the research objective or hypothesis. The suggestions should present matters that will subsequently be conducted in relation to the research's ensuing concepts.

Acknowledgments (11pt, bold, Uppercase)

Collate acknowledgements in a separate section at the end of the article before the references. List here those individuals who provided help during the research (e.g., providing language help, writing assistance or proof reading the article, etc.). Do not number this section.

References (11pt, bold, Uppercase)

All references mentioned should be written down in reference using American Psychological Association (APA) style (**APA 6th edition**) and arranged from A to Z. Cite

the main scientific publications on which your work is based. Cite only items that you have read. Do not inflate the manuscript with too many references. Avoid excessive self-citations. Avoid excessive citations of publications from the same region. Check each reference against the original source (author(s) name, volume, issue, years). **Please use Reference Manager Applications like EndNote, Mendeley, Zotero, etc.** All publications cited in the text should be included as a list of references. Please ensure that every reference cited in the text is also present in the reference list (and vice versa). Please make sure that your manuscript is provided comprehensive references (**at least 30 articles with 80% of them are from reputable journals**). References use at least last 5 years of articles, books or other resources.

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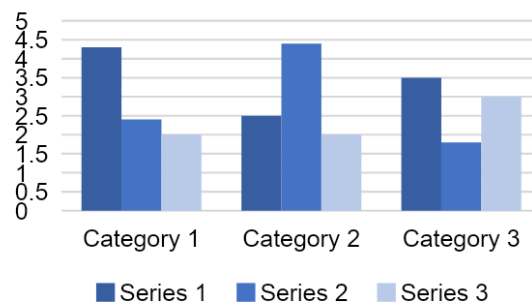
